FACILITATORS are not required to be EXPERTS !!!

- a) Facilitator: the root word is "facil" or "easy" so.... "make things flow easy" for the group you are leading
- b) Facilitators are **neutral**. They **bring out** and **focus on** the collective **wisdom that is** within the group
- Facilitators are like baseball umpires. They are there not to be the focus of attention.
 The players (PEs) play the game.
 Remember, when the umpires have the focus, usually something bad has happened.

Experts:

- 1. Present information
- 2. Provide the "right answers"
- 3. Focus on content
- 4. Practice one way communication (lecture)

<u>While</u> Facilitators:

- 1. Guide the process
- 2. Provide the "right questions"
- 3. Focus on outcomes
- 4. Use multi-dimensional communications skills
